## **Magic Bag of Holding**

Materials: 15 grams (42 yards) of LavenderSheep Twist Yarn

**Needles:** 

2 #8 US 16" circular

OI

#8 US set of DPNs Gauge: 20 sts = 4"

## **Glossary:**

CO: Cast On p: purl
dpn(s): Double Pointed Needle(s) rnd: round
k: knit st(s): Stitch(es)
k2tog: knit 2 together YO: yarn over

CO 40 sts

Divide evenly over 2 circulars or 3 dpns.

Rnd 1-10: k1, p1 Rnd 11-12: k

Rnd 13: \*k3, YO, k2tog\* repeat between \*\* to end

Continue Knitting until piece measures 5" from the bottom edge.

## Bottom

Rnd 1: \*k6, k2tog\* repeat between \*\* to end

Rnd 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, & 12: k

Rnd 3: \*k5, k2tog\* repeat between \*\* to end Rnd 5: \*k4, k2tog\* repeat between \*\* to end Rnd 7: \*k3, k2tog\* repeat between \*\* to end Rnd 9: \*k2, k2tog\* repeat between \*\* to end Rnd 11: \*k1, k2tog\* repeat between \*\* to end



## Finishing

Cut long tail and sew through sts like when knitting a hat. Pull tight and sew end in securely. Cut 3 strands 12" inches long and braid together. Lace the braid through the holes for a secure tie. Sew in any ends.
